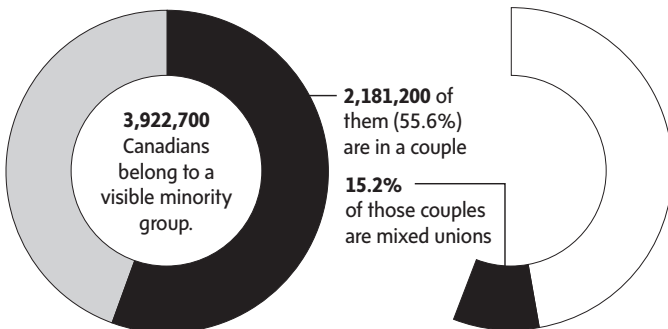


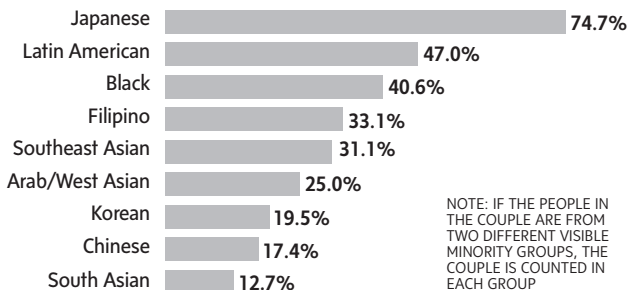
Mixed unions

The Statistics Canada report on couples in mixed-race unions shows they were more likely to live in larger urban centres.



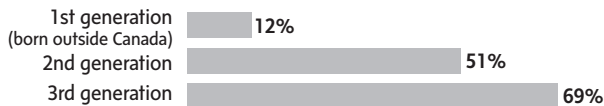
